In accordance with United States Code (U.S.C) Annotated, Title 20, Chapter 70, Subchapter VIII, Part C, Section 7846, and Public Law (P.L.) 114-95, **Every Student Succeeds Act** (ESSA), Section 8306, an entity planning to submit a federal grant application must afford a reasonable opportunity for public comment on the application before it is submitted.

Center ISD hereby gives notice to the public that it intends to file the following applications and request awarded amounts for the federal grant funds with the Texas Education Agency for the school year 2021-2022. CISD welcomes comments or questions concerning any of these grants, and requests that any comments or questions be submitted by August 31, 2021.

- **Title 1, Part A (\$832,348)** provides supplemental resources to help schools with high concentrations of students from low-income families acquire the knowledge and skills in the state content standards and to meet the state student performance standards.
- **Title II, Part A (\$124,702)** increases student achievement through improving teacher and principal quality and increasing the number of highly qualified teachers in classrooms and highly qualified principals in schools.
- **Title III, Part A (\$79,773)** develops programs for limited English proficient students to attain English proficiency, develop high levels of academic attainment, and meet the state content standards and student achievement standards.
- **Title IV, Part A (\$60,622)** improves the academic achievement of all students by providing all students with access to well-rounded education, improving school conditions for students' learning, and improving the use of technology in order to enhance academic outcomes and digital literacy of all students.

Public comments regarding Center ISD applications for the grants are to be submitted before the public comment end date.
